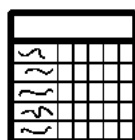

There might not be assemblies

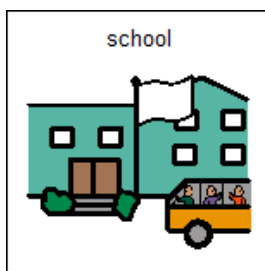
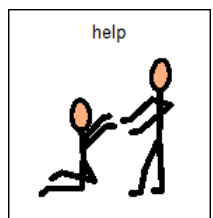


Sometimes change makes me feel worried or sad. That's ok.
