

Subtraction calculations! Write the number sentence and work them out using your chosen method.

In the school library there are 59 fiction books on the top shelf.

Y6 come in and take out 26 books.



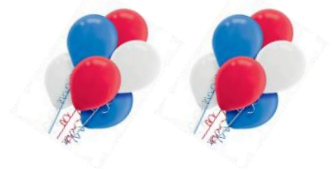
How many fiction books are left on the top shelf?

$$59 - 26 = 33$$

There are 47 balloons at a VE day street party.

Sadly 20 balloons went pop.

How many balloons are left?



$$47 - 20 = 27$$

There are 29 glass bottles in the kitchen.

Grandad took 15 out to the recycling box.

How many bottles are left in the kitchen?

$$29 - 15 = 14$$

Mary has 18 tennis balls.



Sadly she hit 11 over her garden fence.

How many tennis balls does she have left?

$$18 - 11 = 7$$

Oscar had 76 Pokémon cards.



He gave his little brother 35 cards.

How many Pokémon cards does Oscar have now?

$$76 - 35 = 41$$

On Monday Mr Davies put 95 exercise books in the school entrance.

Children and their parents collected 33 to use for their home learning.



How many books are left there now?

$$95 - 33 = 62$$
