As well as the crane, there are many other birds that make their homes in Britain.

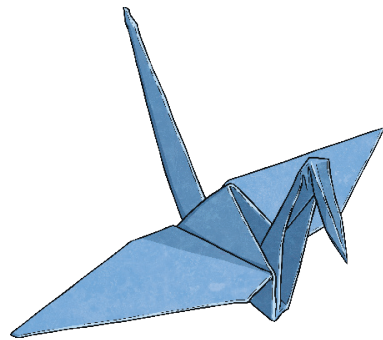
Use reference books or the Internet to explore some of these birds. Test your new knowledge by using this **Garden Birds Self-Marking Activity**.
