Year Six Curriculum Update Spring 1

English

This half-term, we will be using four books to support our learning.

The Girl in the Red Skirt by Lucy Cooley allows us to use this beautifully told tale to explore the use of language in writing, and to write persuasive speeches about kindness and safeguarding the environment.

Shackleton's Journey by William Grill is a visual journey of Earnest Shackleton's epic attempt to cross Antarctica, and used a narrative approach to explore this incredible true story, with beautiful illustrations. The book provides lots of reading and writing opportunities.

Arboretum by Tony Kirkham is a brilliantly detailed non-fiction book that supports our Geography topic about the biomes

And The Nowhere Emporium by Russ MacKenzie is our exciting class story.

We will continue to follow our Spelling and Grammar curriculum

Science

Animals Including Humans

Children will learn to:

- Identify the main parts of the circulatory system.
- Explain the main functions of the heart, lungs and blood vessels in the circulatory system.
- State how the digestive system breaks down nutrients.
- Explain what constitutes a healthy lifestyle.
- Describe how drugs and alcohol can impact negatively on the body.
- Take accurate measures of the pulse rate.
- Record results and write a report which includes a conclusion

Mathematics

To include:

- Fractions, decimals and percentages;
- Multi-Step Word Problems;
- Geometry;
- Measurement and converting between units of measurement;
- Basic skills (multiplication facts, place value and using time);
- Maths fluency (using number knowledge, basic skills and understanding relationships between numbers to calculate fluently using mental computation strategies).

Religious Education

Using the Christian concept of Salvation, children will learn:

To describe and offer thoughtful responses to the distinct beliefs of Christians

To give a clear account of some of the central beliefs and teachings of Christianity

Spanish

Our Spanish unit is Tienes Una Mascota, in which we learn to talk all about our pets.

Music

In our music lessons, we will write, compose and perform our own rap songs!

Art

Art & Fashion and Piet Mondrian

We will study the close links between fashion and art, looking at how clothing design has often been influenced by the work of modern artists such as Piet Mondrian and Victor Vasarely, as well as where artists have collaborated with fashion designers, such as Coco Chanel and Pablo Picasso. As well as studying the art and techniques of such artists, we will also practice using these techniques ourselves in our own recreation of their artwork.

Computing

Introduction to spreadsheets

This unit introduces us to spreadsheets. We will be supported in organising data into columns and rows to create their own data set. We will be taught the importance of formatting data to support calculations, while also being introduced to formulas and will begin to understand how they can be used to produce calculated data.
